<p>*Name 3 things that you want to do before school starts.</p> <p>*What do you need to do your activity?</p> <p>*Who would do your activity with you?</p>	<p>Name something that is:</p> <p>*big *little *thin *thick *soft *hard</p>	<p>Talk about sequences to help with language and organization.</p> <p>How do you make cereal? *What do you need first? *Second? *Next? *Last? *Bowl, cereal, milk, spoon, Eat</p>	<p>Play "I spy" with your child and use action/or function words: "I spy something that..."</p> <p>*keeps food cold – Fridge *we can watch – tv *jumps – rabbit, frog *turns on – lamp *gets clothes clean – washer * Let your child give some to U</p>
<p>Work on using pronouns and prepositions at dinner. While eating, ask your child: *to put napkin on the table *to put the napkin under spoon *to put the napkin in his/her lap *Who is eating (name of food) *Who is drinking (name of drink)? *Who is finished?</p>	<p>Help your child understand and ask questions. Play yes – no game. Ask questions...</p> <p>* Are you a girl? * Can pigs fly? *Are you (name)? *Do you swim in a puddle? *Have the child make up questions to try to trick YOU.</p>	<p>Read a book with your child. Ask them questions about the book using these "wh" words:</p> <p>*<u>What</u> *<u>Where</u> *<u>Who</u> *<u>When</u> *<u>Why</u></p>	<p>Forming and explaining categories: Which one doesn't belong and why?</p> <p>*sand, snowman, ocean – *shoe, sock, drink *dress, football, basketball *red, pizza, green *tv, mommy, daddy *pillow, bed, truck</p>
<p>Name the items for your child and ask them what they do with each one:</p> <p>*sand (build a castle, play) *sandals (wear them) *kite (fly it) *crayons (draw with them) *milk (drink it)</p>	<p>Name something that:</p> <p>*you can ride on (bike, car, bus) *you wear (shirt, pants, socks) *is a toy (blocks, trucks, game) *is sticky (gum, glue) *is hot (sun, stove...) *is wet (pool, water, drink)</p>	<p>Encourage your child to give directions. You start by telling him how to build a tower of blocks...</p> <p>*Stack a blue one on top of a yellow block. *Continue with other directions *Follow the child's directions as he explains how to build...</p>	<p>How would you feel if it were hot all year long?</p> <p>*Tell 2 things that you like about the summer.</p> <p>*Tell something that you don't like about the summer.</p>
